When you first arrive at the tile studio we will guide you through our showroom and explain our tile range. Your experienced tile design consultant will assist you with designing your home.


Once you are happy with your tile selections, we'll package together your selected tile samples and finalise your tile selection paperwork with you.

Selection Day

Rectified

Generally appears on a tile that has either been baked, extruded or pressed. The tiles are cut from a larger format tile to form each tile in the same size as the last, with a sharp 90° edge. These tiles are very popular and visually appealing as they allow for smaller grout joins.



Pressed


A pressed edge tile is formed on a product that has been baked in a kiln. The raw material is cut down to a size, the tile then shrinks to the required size during the baking process - as a result you find a rounded like appearance on the edges. Pressed edge tiles will generally have a thicker grout line in comparison to rectified edge products.



Hand-made

Inspired by the traditional tile making methods of Morocco and the Mediterranean, a hand-made edge often has irregular edges and a textured surface which is ideal for splashbacks or internal feature walls.


Polished

Polished tiles are achieved by mechanically buffing the surface of a matt tile, giving it a highly reflective surface and a stunning, shiny look. These tiles are very easy to clean, stain-resistant and don't require sealing. Polished tiles can be more slippery than other finishes so consideration should be given to the areas of use.




Gloss

Gloss tiles are glazed and have a reflective/mirror shine, making your rooms seem larger and brighter. The gloss finish gives a high-impact, glamorous look. Gloss tiles are available in both floor and wall tiles in a wide variation of sizes.



Shine

Shine tiles are glazed tiles and very similar to gloss tiles, but are slightly less reflective. These tiles also have a better scratch resistance than gloss or polished tiles. Shine finish tiles will give a modern and contemporary feel to your home.



Lappato

Lappato tiles are also known as semi-polished tiles and have a finish between matt and polished. This is a form of tile that has been polished but not deep enough to attain the lustre of a full reflective polish. The surface finish has a slightly uneven nature and is a lot less slippery than polished tiles.



Matt

Matt finish tiles generally have a smooth surface which makes them ideal for floor and wall application creating a tranquil, soothing space in your home and office. Matt finish tiles are ideal for bathrooms, kitchens and living areas.




Structured

Structured tiles are given a special look during the manufacturing process as their surface is changed from a flat to a textured one. The texture of structured tiles ranges from protruding geometric shapes to rugged effects. Structured tiles are the perfect choice for outdoor living as they offer a higher slip resistance.


lay patterns
